ORDINANCE NO. 2013-1

**TO AMEND THE 2012-2013 FISCAL YEAR GENERAL
FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS
FOR GENERAL LEGAL SERVICES AND TO PROVIDE
FOR RELATED MATTERS**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Central desire to have legal counsel for general legal services, including but not limited to, advising at City Council meetings, preparing ordinances, resolutions, requests for proposals and representing the City in any legal matter which may arise during the remainder of the 2012-2013 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor submitted a proposed Annual Operating Budget for the 2012-2013 Fiscal Year appropriating \$85,000.00 for Financial Administration Account No. 000.415.45.330 for Legal Services (“FY 2012-2013 Legal Services Budget”); and

WHEREAS, at the Council’s budget workshop the Mayor stated he would not object to amending the proposed appropriation to \$80,000.00; and

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2012 the Council for the City of Central adopted Ordinance No. 2012-06 appropriating \$30,000.00 for the FY 2012-2013 Legal Services Budget; and

WHEREAS, the \$30,000.00 appropriated for the FY 2012-2013 Legal Services Budget is insufficient to provide general legal services to the City of Central for the remainder of the 2012-2013 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to appropriate additional funds for the FY 2012-2013 Legal Services Budget;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1: The Council for the City of Central hereby amends Ordinance No. 2012-06 adopting the 2012-2013 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget for the City of Central as amended by Ordinance Nos. 2012-13, 2012-14 and 2012-20 to appropriate an additional \$50,000.00 for Financial Administration for Legal Services designated as Account No. 000.415.45.330 for the purpose of providing general legal services to City of Central.

Section 2: Conflicts

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3: Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.






