ORDINANCE NO. 2013-10

TO REVOKE A 10 FOOT UTILITY SERVITUDE LOCATED ON LOT 5 OF CENTRAL SQUARE WHICH IS LOCATED AT THE WEST END OF WAX ROAD EXTENSION IN SECTION 68, T6S, R2E, GLD, EBR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council for the City of Central, State of Louisiana that:

Section 1: The ten foot utility servitude previously dedicated to the City of Central across the eastern portion of the property located on Lot 5 of Central Square which is located at the west end of Wax Road Extension in Section 68, Township 6 South, Range 2 East, Greensburg Land District in the City of Central, Parish of East Baton Rouge, Louisiana is hereby revoked.

Section 2: Conflicts

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.






