ORDINANCE NO. 2013-15

**TO AMEND AND RE-ENACT SECTION 401(B) OF
CHAPTER 4 OF TITLE I AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE
OF PAYMENT DEVICES FOR LOCAL CHARGES AND TO
PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Section 401(B) of Chapter 4 of Title I authorizing acceptance of payment devices for local charges is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

TITLE I. CITY ORGANIZATION

Chapter 4. Payments for Local Charges

Section 401. Types of payments; Receipts

* * *

B. Pursuant to La. R.S 33:2933, payment of local charges may be made via on-line checks, bank drafts, MasterCard® and Discover® for the payment of any local charge exceeding ten (\$10) dollars. Acceptance of a local charge via a payment device shall not discharge the liability therefore, until final settlement or payment of the local charge is received. The local charge will be deemed paid on the date the payment device was initially received unless the payment is returned for insufficient funds. If any payment is returned for insufficient funds, any license or permit issued shall not be valid until final payment for all local charges and costs incurred for the returned payment is received.

Section 2: Conflicts

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication in the Official Journal.


