ORDINANCE NO. 2013-18

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING THE GENERAL FUND BUDGET AND THE DEDICATED FUND BUDGETS FOR THE FRANCHISE FEES, THE HALF CENT SALES AND USE TAX AND THE TRAFFIC CONTRIBUTION FUNDS FOR THE 2013-2014 FISCAL YEAR AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, Shelton “Mac” Watts, in his capacity as Mayor of the City of Central, prepared the proposed General Fund Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the proposed General Fund Budget and the Dedicated Fund Budgets for the Franchise Fees, the Half Cent Sales and Use Tax and the Traffic Contribution Funds were submitted to this City Council for review and consideration; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing on the proposed General Fund Budget and the Dedicated Fund Budgets for the Franchise Fees, the Half Cent Sales and Use Tax and the Traffic Contribution Funds were timely published in the Advocate; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed General Fund Budget and the Dedicated Fund Budgets for the Franchise Fees, the Half Cent Sales and Use Tax and the Traffic Contribution Funds was conducted and amendments have been proposed by the Council;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana:

Section 1: The General Fund Budget for the 2013-2014 Fiscal Year attached hereto as Exhibit A is hereby adopted.

Section 2: The Dedicated Fund Budget for the Franchise Fees for the 2013-2014 Fiscal Year attached hereto as Exhibit B is hereby adopted.

Section 3: The Dedicated Fund Budget for the Half Cent Sales and Use Tax for the 2013-2014 Fiscal Year attached hereto as Exhibit C is hereby adopted.

Section 4: The Dedicated Fund Budget for the Traffic Contribution for the 2013-2014 Fiscal Year attached hereto as Exhibit D is hereby adopted.

Section 3: Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder

of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 3: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.






