ORDINANCE NO. 2013-26

TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2013-18 ENACTING THE
2013-2014 FISCAL YEAR GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO
APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR DEVELOPING A SEWER
MASTER PLAN AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED
MATTERS

WHEREAS, Central is within the East Baton Rouge Sewer Consolidated Sewerage District (“EBRSCO”); and

WHEREAS, adequacy of public sewer impacts economic development and the public health, safety and welfare of Central’s residents; and

WHEREAS, EBRSCO has obtained designs for several sewer improvement projects within Central which are anticipated to be bid within the next twelve months; and

WHEREAS, Central desires to develop a Sewer System Master Plan (“SSMP”) including detailed information regarding anticipated development within Central and to provide Central’s SSMP to EBRSCO in advance of the scheduled sewer improvement projects to ensure that investments in sewer improvements within Central are consistent with anticipated development in Central; and

WHEREAS, the Sewer Master Plan Selection Committee, after reviewing all responses to the Request for Qualifications for Sewer Master Planner and interviewing four of the respondents, has recommended Professional Engineering Consultants Corporation;

WHEREAS, in order for EBRSCO to review information in advance of projects which have been designed and to consider any recommended adjustments to said plans, it is necessary for the SSMP to be completed as soon as possible; and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1: The Council for the City of Central hereby amends Ordinance No. 2013-18 adopting the 2013-2014 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget for the City of Central to appropriate \$60,000 for Sanitation in account 000.432.00.330 for development of a Sewer System Master Plan to be presented to the East Baton Rouge Consolidated Sewerage District for consideration in planned projects and future projects for sewer improvements in Central.

Section 2: Conflicts

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3: Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.






