ORDINANCE NO. 2013-8

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2012-2013 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR INSURANCE AND EQUIPPING AND USING A DONATED VEHICLE AS A POLICE UNIT AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central did not include sufficient funds for liability insurance or anticipate the equipping and use of an additional vehicle as a police unit in the 2012-2013 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget;

WHEREAS, the City of Central has received by donation a vehicle which can be used as a police unit, if properly equipped;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2012-2013 Fiscal Year General Budget to appropriate funds necessary to cover insurance costs and to equip and use a donated vehicle as a police unit.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1: Account No. 000.421.05.520 is hereby increased by \$1,530 to cover liability insurance for the Chief of Police.

Section 2: Account No. 000.421.05.742 is hereby increased by \$150 to cover liability insurance on the donated vehicle.

Section 3: Account No. 000.421.70.430 is hereby increased by \$2,500 to cover anticipated repairs and maintenance to police units.

Section 4: Account No. 000.421.70.742 is hereby increased by \$6,500 to cover the cost equipping the donated vehicle as a police unit including but not limited to painting, decals, mobile radios and push bumpers.

Section 5: Conflicts

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 6: Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder

of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 6: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




