ORDINANCE NO. 2014-13

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MONTHLY COMPENSATION OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE TERM OF OFFICE BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 2014 AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the monthly compensation of Chief of Police was set by Ordinance No. 2007-11 and amended and reenacted by Ordinance No. 2012-27; and

WHEREAS, the individual elected to the position of Chief of Police for the term of office beginning on July 1, 2014 requested that the monthly compensation for the Chief of Police be reduced during his term of office.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Compensation. Section 225(C) of Title 1 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

C. Chief of Police

- (1) Effective July 1, 2007, the monthly compensation of the Chief of Police for the City of Central shall be Two Thousand Two Hundred Eight and 33/100 (\$2,208.33) Dollars per month.
- (2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1) of this subsection, the monthly compensation of the Chief of Police for the City of Central for the term of office beginning on July 1, 2014 shall be Ninety-Nine and 00/100 (\$99.00) Dollars per month. In the event a special election is held prior to December 31, 2018 to fill an unexpired term in the office of Chief of Police, the monthly compensation of the Chief of Police for the City of Central shall be in accordance with paragraph (1) of this subsection.

Section 2. Conflicts. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective on July 1, 2014.




