ORDINANCE NO. 2014-23

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2014-2015 FISCAL YEAR GENERAL BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR RETIREMENT AND OPERATIONAL PURPOSES FOR THE CITY OF CENTRAL AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central did not include funds for retirement required by the Municipal Employee Retirement System for the Mayor of Central in the 2014-15 Fiscal Year General Budget;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central recognizes that the space previously occupied by the Police Department is now vacant and the City of Central will require alternative meeting space to hold various committee meetings and administrative hearings;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central recognizes that rental of Kristenwood for council meetings will no longer be required due to the relocation of the council meetings to the Central High School Theater with no monthly rental;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central recognizes that the final work and invoice for the Sewer Master Plan carried over into the 2014-15 Fiscal Year and that adequate funds were not included in the 2014-15 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2014-15 Fiscal Year General Budget to appropriate funds necessary related to the above stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Account No. 000.413.20.230 is hereby increased by \$10,863.00 to provide for the retirement funds related to the Mayor of Central as required by the Municipal Employees Retirement System.

Section 2. Account No. 000.419.44.441 is hereby increased by \$2,200.00 to provide for the increase in additional rent to retain Suite 7 for the purposes of committee meetings and administrative hearings.

Section 3. Account No. 000.411.10.441 is hereby decreased by \$2,200.00 for the rental of Kristenwood for council meetings due to the relocation of the council meetings to the Central High School Theater.

Section 4. Account No. 000.432.00.330 is hereby increased by \$1,800.00 for the final work and invoice related to the development of a Sewer Master Plan for the City of Central.

Section 5. Conflicts

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 6. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




