ORDINANCE NO. 2014-24

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2014-2015 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR ADDITIONAL SURVEYING WORK FOR THE BEAVER BAYOU FLOODPLAIN STUDY

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central entered into a contract with G.E.C., Inc. with a Notice to Proceed effective April 24, 2013 to perform a study of the Beaver Bayou floodplain in an attempt to revise the Flood Insurance Rate Map within the City of Central;

WHEREAS, the City of Central submitted the results of the study to FEMA representatives on January 3, 2014;

WHEREAS, FEMA representatives have asked for additional information a total of three times so far as part of their review;

WHEREAS, the latest request for information from FEMA representatives dated August 25, 2014 will require additional surveying work along the Beaver Bayou corridor;

WHEREAS, the requested information must be returned to FEMA representatives no later than November 25, 2014 in order to keep the study under active review;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Flood Elevation Study (Account No. 000.418.20.333) is hereby increased by \$4,000.00 to provide for additional surveying work as requested.

Section 2. Conflicts

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.

Notice of public hearing was published in The Advocate on the 9th day of October, 2014.




