ORDINANCE NO. 2014-25

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2014-2015 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR UNIFORMS, TELEPHONE, INTERNET SERVICES, LAW ENFORCEMENT SUPPLIES AND TO ACCOUNT FOR REDUCTIONS IN GENERAL SUPPLIES & OFFICE EXPENSE AND RESERVE OFFICER EXPENDITURES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central included within the Reserve Officer Expenditures of the 2014-15 Fiscal Year General Budget for the City of Central Police Department Uniform expenses and Law Enforcement Supplies; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central wishes to segregate those expenditures in an effort to assist the Chief of Police in the financial management of the Police Department;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central included within the 2014-15 Fiscal Year General Budget for the City of Central Police Department Telephone and Internet Services in the General Supplies & Office Expense; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central wishes to segregate those expenditures in an effort to assist the Chief of Police in the financial management of the Police Department;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2014-2015 Fiscal Year General Budget to properly appropriate funds necessary related to the above stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Uniforms (Account No. 000.421.20.800) is hereby created and increased by \$3,210.00 to provide for expenditures related to uniform expenditures for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 2. Law Enforcement Supplies (Account No. 000.421.20.610) is hereby created and increased by \$3,540.00 to provide for expenditures related to law enforcement supplies for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 3. Reserve Officer Expenditure (Account No. 000.421.21.340) is hereby decreased by \$6,750.00 so that expenditures related to uniforms and law enforcement supplies can be

segregated to assist the Police of Chief in the financial management of the City of Central Police Department.

Section 4. Telephone (Account No. 000.421.05.530) is hereby created and increased by \$1,015.00 to provide for expenditures related to telephone expenditures for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 5. Internet Services (Account No. 000.421.05.531) is hereby created and increased by \$5,165.00 to provide for expenditures related to internet services, which also includes the monthly costs of air cards used by each police unit for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 6. General Supplies & Office Exp (Account No. 000.421.05.610) is hereby decreased by \$6,180.00 so that expenditures related to telephone and internet services can be segregated to assist the Police of Chief in the financial management of the City of Central Police Department.

Section 7. Conflicts

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 8. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 9. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




