7 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MONTHLY
8 COMPENSATION OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE
9 TERM OF OFFICE BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 2014 AND
10 PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS

11
12 WHEREAS, the monthly compensation of Chief of Police was set by Ordinance No.
13 2007-11 and amended and reenacted by Ordinance No. 2012-27; and

14
15 WHEREAS, the individual elected to the position of Chief of Police for the term of
16 office beginning on July 1, 2014 requested that the monthly compensation for the Chief of Police
17 be reduced during his term of office.

18
19 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of
20 Louisiana as follows:

22 **Section 1. Compensation.** Section 225(C) of Title 1 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as
23 follows:

25 C. Chief of Police

26
27 (1) Effective July 1, 2007, the monthly compensation of the Chief of
28 Police for the City of Central shall be Two Thousand Two Hundred
29 Eight and 33/100 (\$2,208.33) Dollars per month.

30 (2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1) of this subsection, the monthly
31 compensation of the Chief of Police for the City of Central for the
32 term of office beginning on July 1, 2014 shall be Ninety-Nine and
33 00/100 (\$99.00) Dollars per month. In the event a special election is
34 held prior to December 31, 2017 to fill an unexpired term in the office
35 of Chief of Police, the monthly compensation of the Chief of Police
36 for the City of Central shall be in accordance with paragraph (1) of this
37 subsection.

39 **Section 2. Conflicts.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are
40 hereby repealed.

41
42 **Section 3. Severability.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this
43 Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of
44 invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the
45 part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of
46 invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

2 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be effective on July 1, 2014.
