ORDINANCE NO. 2015-15

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2014-2015 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE RECEIPT OF A DONATION OF A COMMAND TRAILER, SECOND CHANCE VEST, AND FURNITURE FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central did not include within the 2014-15 Fiscal Year General Budget for the City of Central Police Department, receipt of a donation for a command trailer, second chance vest, and furniture by the City of Central Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2014-2015 Fiscal Year General Budget to properly appropriate funds necessary related to the above stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Equipment-PD (Account No. 000.421.05.741) is hereby increased by \$19,433.75 to provide for the donated command trailer for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 2. Small Equipment (Account No. 000.421.05.744) is hereby increased by \$728.00 to provide for donation of a second chance vest for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 3. Furniture & Fixtures-PD (Account No. 000.421.05.743) is hereby created and increased by \$6,275.00 to provide for donated furniture for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 4. Donations-PD (Account No. 000.364.20) is hereby increased by \$26,436.75 for the donation received related to the command trailer, second chance vest, and furniture by the City of Central Police Department.

Section 5. Conflicts

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity

of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 7. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.






