7 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2015-2016 FISCAL
8 YEAR HALF-CENT FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE
9 FUNDS FOR DETAILED UTILITY SURVEYING FOR THE
10 FRENCHTOWN ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND
11 TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

13 WHEREAS, the Council has authorized the design of a road improvement project for a
14 portion of Frenchtown Road under an ordinance passed during the February 24, 2015 regular
15 council meeting;

16
17 WHEREAS, the consultant and the City of Central have identified a need for more detailed
18 utility surveying services than what was provided under the original scope of work in order to
19 mitigate possible delays during construction caused by utility conflicts;

20
21 WHEREAS, the Council did not include funding for this additional utility surveying work
22 within the 2015-2016 Half-Cent Fund Budget;

23
24 WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2015-2016 Fiscal
25 Year Half-Cent Fund Budget to properly appropriate necessary funds related to the above stated
26 matters.

28 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of
29 Louisiana as follows:

31 **Section 1:** Construction (Half-Cent Fund Account No. 120.431.10.730) is hereby increased by
32 \$22,500.00 to provide for the expenditures related to the utility surveying costs for the Frenchtown
33 Road improvements (Greenwell Springs Road to Central Thruway).

35 **Section 2. Conflicts:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are
36 hereby repealed.

38 **Section 3. Severability:** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this
39 Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of
40 invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the
41 part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of
42 invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

44 **Section 4. Effective Date:** This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
