7 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2014-2015 FISCAL
8 YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE
9 RECEIPT OF A DONATION OF A USED POLICE TRUCK,
10 VEHICLE INSURANCE, AND DONATED SERVICES
11 RELATED TO EXPENDITURES OF USED POLICE
12 TRUCK FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO
13 PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

15 WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central did not include within the 2014-15 Fiscal
16 Year General Budget for the City of Central Police Department, receipt of a donation for a used
17 police truck by the City of Central Police Department and related expenditures to put that vehicle
18 in service; and

20 WHEREAS, the City of Central Police Department has received a donation to assist with
21 necessary expenditures related to the used police truck;

23 WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2014-2015 Fiscal
24 Year General Budget to properly appropriate funds necessary related to the above stated matters.

26 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of
27 Louisiana as follows:

29 **Section 1.** Vehicles-PD (Account No. 000.421.70.742) is hereby increased by \$31,783.41 to
30 provide for the donated used police truck and necessary renovations of the used police truck for
31 the City of Central Police Department.

33 **Section 2.** Insurance-Vehicle (Account No. 000.421.05.742) is hereby increased by \$420.63
34 to provide for expenditures related to the cost of insurance for the used police truck for the City
35 of Central Police Department.

37 **Section 3.** Donations-PD (Account No. 000.364.20) is hereby increased by \$29,402.77 for
38 the donation received related to the used police truck and required renovations for the used
39 police truck for the City of Central Police Department.

41 **Section 4. Conflicts**

43 All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

45 **Section 5. Severability**

1 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court
2 of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity
3 of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder
4 of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force
5 and effect.

7 **Section 6. Effective Date**

9 This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
