ORDINANCE NO. 2016-07

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2015-2016 HALF CENT FUND FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE DENHAM ROAD & HUBBS ROAD INTERSECTION AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council and the Mayor of the City of Central desires to make necessary roadway improvements at the Denham Road and Hubbs Road intersection; and

WHEREAS, Professional Engineering Consultants Corp had estimated the construction costs to be \$30,000 for the roadway improvements at the Denham Road and Hubbs Road intersection;

WHEREAS, the actual costs of the construction is \$31,200 and as a result, the Council did not include adequate funding for the construction phase of this project within the Half Cent Fund in the 2015-16 Budget;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2015-2016 Fiscal Year Half Cent Budget to properly appropriate necessary funds related to the above stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Construction (Half Cent Fund Account No. 120.431.10.730) is hereby increased by \$1,200.00 to provide for the expenditures related to the construction costs of the intersection improvements at Denham Road and Hubbs Road.

Section 2. Conflicts

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




