ORDINANCE NO. 2016-15

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2015-2016 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO USED POLICE MOTORCYCLE UNITS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, INSURANCE, REDUCTION IN EQUIPMENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central did not include within the 2015-16 Fiscal Year General Budget for the City of Central Police Department sufficient funds for the purchase of two used motorcycle police units by the City of Central Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the purchase price of the used motorcycle police units is \$1.00 each;

WHEREAS, the City of Central Police Department recognizes that the police motorcycle units are valued at an estimate of \$8,000.00 each;

WHEREAS, the City of Central Police Department will incur additional insurance costs for the motorcycle police units of \$181.00 along with costs of \$2,819.00 to install equipment on the motorcycle police units.

WHEREAS, the City of Central Police Department will not purchase all laptops as originally budgeted in the current fiscal year.

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2015-2016 Fiscal Year General Budget to properly appropriate funds necessary related to the above stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Vehicles-PD (Account No. 000.421.70.742) is hereby increased by \$18,819.00 to provide for the purchase of two used motorcycle police units for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 2. Donations-PD (Account No. 000.364.20) is hereby increased by \$15,998.00 for a donation received related to difference in estimated value and purchase price of the used motorcycle police units for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 3. Insurance-Vehicles (Account No. 000.421.05.742) is hereby increased by \$181.00 for the additional cost of insurance related to the purchase of the two used motorcycle police units.

Section 4. Equipment-PD (Account No. 000.421.05.741) is hereby decreased by \$3,000.00 as a result of the City of Central Police Department not purchasing all laptops included in the original budget.

Section 5. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 6. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 7. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




