**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2016-23
THE 2016-2017 FISCAL YEAR GENERAL FUND BUDGET
TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR ENGINEERING &
SURVEYING SERVICES AND RELATED CONSULTING
SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF CENTRAL HYDROLOGIC
AND HYDRAULIC ANALYSES AND FLOOD MAPPING
PROJECT FOR BLACKWATER BAYOU AND
TRIBUTARIES 1, 2 AND 3 – DRAUGHANS CREEK – HUBBS
BAYOU WATERSHEDS AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED
MATTERS**

WHEREAS, The City of Central has previously funded and implemented a FEMA Letter of Map Revision (LOMR) to update decades old topographic data and modeling of the Beaver Bayou watershed; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor of the City of Central in cooperation with the engineering consultant who was contracted to perform the Beaver Bayou Study has identified areas recommended by the engineering consultant, who performed the Beaver Bayou LOMR, which are recommended to be restudied in order to update flood map data.

WHEREAS, The Mayor of the City of Central has received a proposal dated June 22, 2016 to study other areas and watersheds within the City from Mr. George Hudson, P.E. of Gulf Engineers & Consultants; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Central asserts the fact that updated flood maps for the city will protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Central; and

WHEREAS, the Council authorizes the Mayor to sign the professional services proposal relative to the engineering work described as Phase 1, said work being more completely detailed in the scope section of the proposal with a proposed fee of \$76,900.00; and

WHEREAS, the Council authorizes the Mayor to sign the professional services proposal relative to the necessary surveying work described as Phase 1, said work being more completely detailed in the scope section of the proposal with a proposed fee of \$97,875.00; and

WHEREAS, the additional engineering work to complete the project shown as Phase 2 in the proposal will require additional allocation of funds from the City Council prior to commencing Phase 2, said work being more completely detailed in the scope section of the proposal with a proposed fee of \$73,050.00; and

1 WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2016-2017 Fiscal
2 Year General Fund Budget to properly appropriate necessary funds related to the above stated
3 matters.

5 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of
6 Louisiana as follows:

8 **Section 1.** Zoning & Elevation Studies (General Fund Account No. 000.418.20.333) is hereby
9 increased by \$174,775.00 to provide for the expenditures related to the consulting services
10 described above as Phase 1 and Surveying for the City of Central Hydrologic and Hydraulic
11 analyses and Flood Mapping Project for Blackwater Bayou and Tributaries 1, 2 and 3 – Draughans
12 Creek – Hubbs Bayou watersheds. Said Proposal being attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A.

14 **Section 2. Conflicts**

16 The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other ordinances of the
17 City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

20 **Section 3. Severability**

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22 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of
23 competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of
24 the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of
25 the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and
26 effect.
