**TO PROMOTE MAJOR GENE COBB (A CURRENT

AND TO ABOLISH THE POSITION OF DEPUTY CHIEF ON

WHEREAS, Major Gene Cobb currently serves as a volunteer police officer with the City of Central Police Department;

WHEREAS, La. R.S. 33:423 authorizes the Chief of Police of the City of Central to make recommendations to the Mayor and members of the Council for the City of Central for the promotion of officers;

WHEREAS, Police Chief James Salsbury, Central Police Department, has recommended that Major Gene Cobb be promoted to the rank of Deputy Chief of the City of Central Police Department;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council for the City of Central desire to promote Major Gene Cobb to the rank of Deputy Chief of the Central Police Department;

WHEREAS, Gene Cobb intends to retire on June 30, 2016, at which time the Police Chief James Salsbury, Central Police Department, wishes to abolish the position of Deputy Chief of the Central Police Department;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Central that Major Gene Cobb is hereby promoted to the position of Deputy Chief of the Central Police Department. Upon his retirement on June 30, 2016, the position of Deputy Chief of the Central Police Department shall be abolished.
